

# English C Course

## Semester 1 2005

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**Theme: Travel English**

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Lecturer's name: **Ron Murphy**

Course objectives:

To develop language skill appropriate for various situations abroad.  
To learn the various issues related to travel: cultural and environmental impact of travel, reasons for travel, etc.  
To gain a better understanding of the countries and cultures through listening and reading tasks.

Course content: There will be group discussions and conversation practice for travel situations. There will also be various listening and reading activities which students will respond to via written response.

Information for students: This course is designed to help students handle the practical matters of travel (airports, hotels, tipping, problem-solving, directions, etc.), but is also intended to help students consider ways of experiencing the culture of the country in which they are traveling. Students whose idea of "an interesting trip" is simply shopping, theme parks, and sunbathing should take a different class.

Textbook/materials: Text and listening materials provided. Students are expected to bring dictionaries, notebooks, and at least one floppy disk to each class.

Evaluation: Demonstrated ability to function conversationally in specific situations (50%). Written assignments, project work (50%).
