Students who are absent from a class should ask a classmate about the content of the missed lesson, and get information about preparation, review, homework, etc.</li> <li>3. Three absences will be allowed. In the case of four or more absences, a student will not receive credit for the class.</li> <li>4. Students who are late will have difficulty joining class activities. They should be in the classroom before class begins. Three late arrivals will be considered an absence. Arriving 30 or more minutes late will be considered an absence.</li> <li>5. As a rule, class activities should be done in English. Please take this opportunity to practice using English.</li> <li>6. During class, cell phones should be turned off and private conversations avoided.</li> <li>7. Without credit for English A or English FA, students cannot enroll for English B.</li> </ol>
