1	Name of Subject	Studying English Abroad I
2	Key Words	study abroad, home stay, immersion English
3	Class Aims	This class aims to make students more proficient in authentic, daily communication in a foreign country, and to help them understand foreign cultures.
4	Class Goals	Students should be able to do everyday tasks in English while abroad -- shopping, banking, using public transportation, and doing things around a home with host family members. Students should be able to use English in the class with students from different cultures to discuss various topics in-depth and to participate positively in activities outside class.

7	Class Content	There will be a series of preparatory classes in which students learn about things such as filling out applications, home stay behavior and expectations, money, shopping, public transportation, etc. In a foreign country, students will participate in an intensive English course in which they will participate in various discussions, presentations, vocabulary-building exercises, and listening exercises. There will also be some reading and writing. The post classes will include a written essay of 400-600 words, and a presentation in which they discuss their experience, suggest improvements, and answer questions.
8	Class Schedule	This course consists of three segments: 1. Preparatory Classes: - Application to the institution and homestay - Money issues in a foreign country - Home stay expectations, behavior and language - Safety, local law, and transportation - Local culture 2. Intensive English courses (options): ワシントン大学シアトル校 (Educational Outreach) カリフォルニア大学ロサンゼルス校 (Extension, ALC) バンガー大学 (日本研究所、トリニティーファウンデーションプログラム) プリティッシュ・コロンビア大学 (ELA) ELA Lanaguage Centers - 20 hours of classroom time per week for three weeks. 3. Post classes - Reflection and feedback - Essay submission, presentation, and discussion.
