2	Key Words	Academic Writing; Essay writing; creative nonfiction; Style
3	Class Aims	This course aims to provide students with the basic strategies of writing in different genres. Students will be exposed to and required to write in two different fields: academic writing and creative (nonfiction) writing.
4	Class Goals	By the end of this course, students will be able to: Communicate effectively through writing. Demonstrate an ability to use appropriate styles according to genre Follow the process of writing from first to final draft. Provide and receive constructive criticism on their writing in workshops
