2	Key Words	Internet search, reading, strategies, graded readers, summarizing
3	Class Aims	This class aims to help students learn how to efficiently deal with native English texts -- how to determine what is important, and what is not important -- so that students can search efficiently for information. Students will learn how to gather information and report it through presentation or report, and how to work in a professional environment (boss's orders, clients' needs, etc.)
4	Class Goals	By the end of this course students will be able to: a. more easily accomplish tasks using English language websites b. understand and use English language newspapers and on-line content for work or pleasure c. improve reading fluency and endurance through extensive reading d. give opinions on various situations, main ideas, and important relationships through discussions based on written texts

7	Class Content	Students will be 'staff' in a scenario common to a business setting. They will use the Internet to find information appropriate to the assignment, and report on it. They will also work with print and on-line newspapers. Graded readers will also be used. Students will work on projects in groups and in pairs. There will be written reports, summaries, and presentations.
8	Class Schedule	Week 1- Introduction; communicative strategies & reading strategies Week 2 - Summarizing published content; Focus on goal: Good vs. bad decision-making Week 3 - Project 1 intro: Internet search Week 4 - Project 1 continue: Gather information from sources, compile it, discussion Week 5 - Project 1 conclusion: summary and recommendation Week 6 - Understanding English language newspapers Week 7 - Understanding English language on-line newspapers; other media sources Week 8 - Readers Forums: discussion. Week 9 - Project 2: begin (similar to project 1) Week 10 - Project 2: Gather information from sources, summarize it, group discussion Week 11 - Project 2: Summaries and recommendations Week 12 - Graded Reader, extensive reading Week 13 - Graded Reader text analysis, discussion Week 14 - Project 3 presentations (stage 1) Week 15 - Project 3 presentations (stage 2)
