2	Key Words	Strategies – Academic Writing – Essays – Critical Thinking – Peer Editing
3	Class Aims	This course will help students recognize and produce writing that would be expected for university courses overseas by introducing different paragraph types through to essay structure.
4	Class Goals	By the end of this course students will be able to understand different types of paragraph structure, the purpose of and how to outline an essay, and how to manage time in academic writing situations.
